

Halloween Spooktacular Dance Rules and Expectations

Tickets will be sold October 19-24, during all three lunches. Names will be taken down for those who have paid and have turned in a signed expectation form. Wristbands will be given out at that time. We will not accept forms without payment. Lost or torn wristbands may be replaced for \$1.00—see Mrs. Karch.

Tickets sold after October 21st will be \$7.00.

The Halloween Dance is a chaperoned activity for all students enrolled at Hyde Park and who have not been suspended during the current quarter. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all students, the dance guidelines below will be enforced. This signed expectation form is required to purchase a dance wristband. Please read the information below.

Price of tickets include photo booth picture, face painting, donut eating contest, pie eating contest, and other activities. Snacks, popcorn, soda, water, and candy will be sold for \$1.00 each.

DANCE GUIDELINES

- All Hyde Park and CCSO rules apply.
- Students are NOT allowed to leave until the end of the dance unless a parent picks them up in the cafeteria.
- Dance wristbands must be pre-purchased. Sales will take place during lunch times only.
- Students must purchase their own wristband.
- **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS.**
- Doors will open at 2:11 PM and the dance will conclude promptly at 3:25 PM.
- Only Hyde Park students will be allowed to attend the dance. **NO** exceptions.
- Running and physical aggressive contact will result in removal from the dance.
- Slam dancing, break dancing, and sexually suggestive dancing are not allowed.
- School dress code will be enforced. **Costumes may be worn to this dance but faces cannot be covered.**
- Students must enter the dance immediately after school dismissal. **No one will be admitted to the dance after 2:30** unless they have been working with a teacher and have a pass.

TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

- Parents need to be here to pick up their students no later than 3:25 PM.
- Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of student.
- Students who use school bus transportation to arrive at school may ride the late bus home.
- There will be NO supervision after 3:40 PM.
- Students not picked up by 3:40 PM will be required to ride the late bus home.

Students not abiding by these rules will be required to leave the dance and will not receive a refund. Students found to be violating school rules will be subject to disciplinary action.
