## **SAVILLE MS EVENT POLICY GUIDELINES**

On behalf of the Saville Middle School administration, staff and students - Welcome. The information listed below is intended to assist you, your team, fans, and our game administrative staff to ensure a safe, secure and enjoyable environment for all. Please share it with your administration, coaches, fans and student body. Saville Middle School abides by the mission of CCSD Middle School Athletics Program- to enhance student achievement through the development of teamwork, citizenship, and self-discipline and The Silver Rule- "DO NOT DO TO OTHERS WHAT YOU DO NOT WANT THEM TO DO TO YOU.

Saville Middle School will enforce a Family Event Policy at all paid home athletic events. Following are the guidelines of the policy:

- 1. All students must show a current school ID for admittance.
- 2. Only Saville Middle School students, students from the visiting teams, and feeder school students will be allowed admittance.
- 3. Non-students and younger/older students (below 6<sup>th</sup> grade will only be allowed admittance with an adult over 21 years of age.
- 4. Ticket prices are: Adult-\$3; Student \$1; children under 5 are free
- 5. Spectators will sit on the west side of the bleachers.
- 6. Only teams and their coaches will sit on the east side of the bleachers.
- 7. Outside food or drinks will not be allowed in athletic events.
- 8. There will be no re-admittance into paid athletic events if a student leaves during the event.
- 9. Adults may be re-admitted with the designated hand stamp.
- 10. Family passes must have the six names printed on the back of the pass.
- 11. Anti-social and unsportsmanlike behavior is prohibited. Attendees exhibiting those behaviors will be removed or will be refused admittance. Additional consequences per CCSD Behavior Guidelines and Saville Middle School Behavior Guidelines may be applicable.
- 12. The use of noise makers of any kind are not allowed. This includes, but is not limited to, thunder sticks, air horns, or other loud devices. These items will be confiscated.

- 13. Booing, taunting or intimidating the officials and opponents is unsportsmanlike and unacceptable.
- 14. Yelling, screaming, stomping or noise making to distract the student athlete during foul shots is unsportsmanlike and unacceptable.
- 15. Students who are removed from an athletic contest will be prohibited from attendance at athletic contests.
- 16. Cheer leaders are not permitted under the baskets at the baseline.
